The mission of the Mile Hi Veterans Education Committee shall be to provide scholarships and other educational benefits to Veterans, members and their families.

ELIGIBILITY (Applicants must meet <u>ALL</u> of the following requirements):

- High school senior, graduate, GED recipient, or continuing post-secondary student.
- Hispanic background or involvement with the Hispanic community.
- Accepted for enrollment for the fall 2025 semester in a certificate, vocational or degree program.
- Minimum of a 2.5 cumulative grade point average (GPA) or GED completion.
- A Colorado resident.
- Applicant is a Veteran, a current member (for at least one full year) of the Mile Hi Veterans or sponsored by a family member that is a MHV member (for at least one full year).
- Recipients are expected to attend the Scholarship Awards Reception to be held on July 20, 2025.
- Two Letters of Recommendation, from non-family members. **MUST** be current and received no later than May 16, 2025, 5 p.m. MST.
- **PERSONAL ESSAY** Submit a typed, double-spaced 250-to-500-word essay (details in application).
- Submit copies of GED certification, **OR** post-secondary transcript **AND** proof of registration/enrollment for Fall 2025 semester.
- Applicants must meet ALL eligibility requirements. If for any reason the application is incomplete or is not submitted by the stated deadline, that applicant will be ineligible.
